Effective May 1, 2019, the Office of Contract Compliance will **no longer** be issuing approval letters for DBE annual updates. To determine if your firm is currently DBE certified and/or to verify NAICS codes, please refer to the online DBE Directory. The DBE Directory is **updated daily** and contains a **complete list of all certified firms**. If anyone needs confirmation of DBE status, please direct them to the directory.

You will **still receive email confirmation** that your firm's update has been accepted and approved by CTDOT. This will replace the letter format. If you have questions, please feel free to reach out to me.

Re: DBE CERTIFICATION ANNUAL REVIEW NOTICE

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) has completed its review of the Affidavit of "No Change" submitted on behalf of your firm in fulfillment of its annual submission requirement. We are pleased to advise you that your firm continues to meet the eligibility criteria established by the U.S. Department of Transportation Disadvantaged Business Enterprise regulation, codified at 49 CFR, Part 26, and remain CERTIFIED as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) with CTDOT.

Your firm's certification with CTDOT will remain effective for as long as your firm continues to meet all DBE Certification eligibility requirements and the ownership and control of the firm, upon which DBE certification was granted, has not changed. However, your firm's compliance with DBE certification eligibility criteria will be reviewed on an annual basis.

You are required to submit, annually, a sworn affidavit affirming that there have been no changes in your firm's economic disadvantaged status, ownership or control. In the event that there are changes, please be advised that you are required to notify CTDOT, within 30 days, of any changes in your business' ownership, control and/or operations including address, telephone number, business services, capabilities, and, for out-of-state firms, any changes that occur with your home-state certification. Failure to adhere to these requirements may result in the removal of DBE certification status. Your firm's next annual submission will be due on or before **6/1/2019**.
