Dear Ms. D'Agostino:

Congratulations! The Massachusetts Unified Certification Program (MassUCP) on behalf of MassDOT, is pleased to notify you that your company has been granted your description rewrite. Your company's primary economic activity as a disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE) is identified as **NAICS Code(s) 423320, 423510, 424950, 423720 and 425120**. Your business description now reads **"SUPPLIER OF COMMERCIAL & INDUSTRIAL BUILDING, CONSTRUCTION & MAINTENANCE MATERIALS INCLUDING PLUMBING, HVAC, ELECTRICAL, PAINT, FINISHES, COATINGS, REBAR, LUMBER, LED & SOLAR SIGNAGE, GEOTEXTILES, STRUCTURAL STEEL & BUILDING MATERIALS"**. Your firm's designation as a DBE will appear in the Massachusetts Central Register and the DBE Certified Business Listing of eligible firms for federal-aid transportation projects.

As a DBE, you must inform MassUCP in writing of changes affecting your size, disadvantaged status, ownership, control requirements or in any of the information provided in your application form. Changes in management responsibility among members of a limited liability company are covered by this requirement. You must attach supporting documentation describing in detail the nature of such changes. The notice must take the form of an affidavit sworn to by the owners of the firm before a person who is authorized by state law to administer oaths or of an un-sworn declaration executed under penalty of perjury of the laws of the United States. You must provide the written notification within thirty (30) days of the occurrence of the change. If you fail to make timely notification of such a change, you will be deemed to have failed to cooperate under 49 CFR 26.109(c).

You must update your firm's DBE certification, if it continues to meet the applicable criteria, on or before your firm's certification anniversary date of **July 21, 2021** each year. To do so, you will need to submit:


- (1) No Change Affidavit (**will be sent with reminder letter**)
- (2) A **signed** copy of your company's, and all of its affiliates', U.S. Tax Returns including all schedules and attachments for the year(s) indicated.
- (3) A **signed** copy of your personal tax returns for year(s) indicated.
- (4) If a sole proprietor, **a signed** copy of your Schedule C. for year(s) indicated.
- (5) A **statement** of the **number only** of full- and part-time employees (including owner) for each year indicated.

MassUCP reserves the right to monitor, perform random spot checks, re-evaluate the firm or revoke the firm's certification if it no longer meets the certification criteria.

If you have changed your company name or address, please notify Ms. Nedra D. White, in writing on the company's letterhead in order to update your state vendor file.
